LITIGATION UPDATE

Mountainstar Gold Inc., the Company, is pleased to inform the public that the Supreme Court of Chile ruled on January 30, 2015 in case number 23178-2014 originating from the 1st Civil Court, in the City of Vallenar, in the State of Copiapo. The decision confirms that Hector Unda Llanos was judged to be an employee from 1996 to date of Minera Nevada SpA, a wholly owned Chile subsidiary of Barrick Gold Corporation.

Mr. Unda Llanos is a mining engineer who over-staked our partner, Jorge Lopehandia's Amarillo Sur and Amarillo Norte mining claims on February 28, 1997 with the Tesoros mining claims. This was done four days before Barrick wrongfully took away the Amarillo Sur and Amarillo Norte mining claims from Lopehandia with a \$20 equivalent contract.

Barrick's lawyer represented in the main case, C 1912-2001 originating in the 14th Civil Court, Santiago, Chile, that Hector Unda Llanos "did not know or have any affiliation to Barrick".

The Company will exercise its rights under Chilean, Canadian and International law.
